Meaning: Stemma: a diagram or chart that depicts the relationships and lineage among texts, manuscripts, or versions, often used in textual criticism and historical research.

1. The linguist presented a detailed stemma to illustrate the relationships between the ancient texts.
2. In historical research, a stemma can clarify the lineage of manuscripts and their variants.
3. The family tree served as a stemma, depicting how the various branches had evolved over generations.
4. When analyzing the evolution of a language, scholars often create a stemma to map out its development.
5. The editor used a stemma to guide decisions about which version of the manuscript to publish.
