

# STIPULED

*Meaning: STIPULATED: specified or required as a condition or term in an agreement or proposal.*

1. The contract stipulated that all parties must agree to the terms before proceeding.
2. She stipulated her requirements clearly in the proposal to avoid any misunderstandings.
3. The judge stipulated that the defendant must attend all hearings without fail.
4. He stipulated a deadline for the project to ensure timely completion.
5. The agreement was only valid if both parties stipulated their consent in writing.
