

STOAK

Meaning: STOAK (verb): To stack or arrange (hay, wood, or similar materials) in a tidy manner.

1. The farmer decided to stoak the hay in the barn before the rain started.
2. In the dim light, she could see the stoak of wood stacked neatly by the fireplace.
3. To ensure a good burn, it's important to arrange the stoak properly in the fire pit.
4. During the winter, they would often gather around the stoak, sharing stories and warmth.
5. He carefully placed a few logs on the stoak, knowing it would keep them cozy all night.
