

# STOCCADE

*Meaning: Stoccade: a defensive barrier or stockade made of pointed stakes or timber, used to protect a fort or position from attack.*

1. The general ordered the construction of a stoccade to defend the fort from attack.
2. During the battle, the soldiers took refuge behind the stoccade, providing them with a strategic advantage.
3. In old military tactics, a stoccade served as a temporary barrier to impede enemy advancement.
