

STOMATE

Meaning: Stomate: a small opening on the surface of a leaf that facilitates gas exchange and regulates water loss in plants.

1. The stomate on the leaf surface allows for gas exchange during photosynthesis.
2. In dry conditions, the stomate may close to conserve water in the plant.
3. Researchers studied how temperature changes affect the opening and closing of stomates.
4. Each stomate is surrounded by guard cells that regulate its size and function.
5. The presence of numerous stomates can indicate a plant's adaptation to its environment.
