Meaning: STOMP (verb): to bring down one's foot heavily and noisily, often in frustration or play.

2. The children began to stomp around the puddles, splashing water everywhere.
3. She could hear the sound of heavy boots stomping down the hall.
4. In the final moments of the game, the crowd erupted, stomping their feet in excitement.
5. He tried to stay calm, but the loud music made him want to stomp in time with the beat.
