

STOP-GAP

Meaning: A stop-gap is a temporary solution or measure used to address an immediate problem until a more permanent fix can be implemented.

1. The committee implemented a stop-gap measure to address the budget shortfall temporarily.
2. In the absence of a permanent solution, they agreed to use a stop-gap strategy to keep the project afloat.
3. The stop-gap funding allowed the organization to continue its essential services while seeking a long-term solution.
4. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the team decided to create a stop-gap plan to meet the deadline.
5. While the new software was being developed, the company relied on a stop-gap application to manage customer data.
