

# STOPSHIP

*Meaning: Stopship (noun): An official order or notice that prevents a vessel or shipment from departing or being processed, typically due to safety or compliance issues.*

1. The port issued a stopship order to prevent the vessel from leaving due to safety concerns.
2. Her shipment was delayed because a stopship notice was placed on it after a compliance issue was discovered.
3. The customs officials enacted a stopship protocol as they investigated potential smuggling activities.
4. Once the stopship alert was activated, all cargo operations were halted until further notice.
5. The company had to implement a stopship strategy to address the defective products that had been distributed.
