Meaning: Straddling: sitting or standing with a leg on either side of something; also, being in a position that encompasses or spans two different options or categories.

1. The child was straddling the bike, preparing for her first ride.
2. He found himself straddling two different career paths, unsure of which to choose.
3. The fence was designed for straddling the property line, clearly marking the boundaries.
4. She demonstrated her flexibility by straddling the yoga mat with ease.
5. In the debate, he was straddling both sides of the issue, trying to appeal to everyone.
