Meaning: STREEK (verb): To apply or spread in a streaked manner, often referring to colors or objects being moved or arranged in a line or band.

1. The artist decided to streak vibrant colors across the canvas to convey her emotions.
2. As the wind picked up, it began to streak the leaves across the path.
3. He used a fine brush to streak the paint delicately along the edges of the sculpture.
4. The lightning began to streak the sky, illuminating the night with brief flashes.
5. In her excitement, she would often streak her hair back with her hands before speaking.
