Meaning: Strick (verb): to remove or eliminate something in order to adjust or improve a situation or plan.

1. The teacher decided to strick the lesson plan and focus on the students' needs instead.
2. After much discussion, they agreed to strick a balance between work and leisure for better productivity.
3. He aimed to strick the right chord with his audience during the presentation.
4. In an effort to strick a deal, she was willing to negotiate the terms of the contract.
5. The chef was careful to strick the right amount of seasoning to enhance the dish's flavor.
