

STRINGENDO

Meaning: Stringendo is a musical term indicating a gradual increase in tempo or intensity, often used to heighten excitement or urgency in a performance or narrative.

1. The conductor signaled a stringendo to intensify the final crescendo of the symphony.
2. As the tension in the story built, the author employed a stringendo to draw readers toward the climax.
3. During the performance, the violinist's stringendo added a sense of urgency to the piece.
4. The stringendo in the final movement left the audience breathless, eager for the resolution.
