

STROBILA

Meaning: Strobila refers to a developmental stage in certain organisms, such as tapeworms and jellyfish, characterized by a series of segments or structures formed through asexual reproduction.

1. The strobila of the tapeworm consists of a series of segments that are continuously produced behind the scolex.
