

STROBOSCOPE

Meaning: A stroboscope is a device that produces regular flashes of light to create the illusion of slowed or stopped motion, often used in the analysis of rapidly moving objects.

1. The stroboscope created an illusion of stillness as the dancer moved in rapid succession.
2. Engineers used a stroboscope to analyze the motion of rotating machinery for troubleshooting.
3. During the science fair, the students demonstrated the effect of a stroboscope on a spinning wheel.
4. The photographer adjusted the stroboscope settings to capture crisp images of the fast-moving object.
5. In the lab, the stroboscope helped visualize the frequency of vibrations in the metal rod.
