Meaning: To stultify means to cause to lose enthusiasm, creativity, or confidence, often through repetitive or critical actions.

1. The repetitive tasks began to stultify her creativity and enthusiasm for the project.
2. His constant criticism seemed designed to stultify any confidence she had in her abilities.
3. The rigid curriculum can often stultify students, leaving little room for exploration.
4. Rather than inspire innovation, the strict guidelines may stultify the team's potential.
5. She feared that the bureaucratic procedures would stultify the progress of the initiative.
