

STYLOID

Meaning: Styloid (adjective): relating to a slender, pointed projection or process, specifically referring to the styloid process of a bone, such as the temporal bone, that serves as an attachment point for muscles and ligaments.

1. The styloid process of the temporal bone serves as an important attachment point for several muscles and ligaments in the neck.
2. During the surgery, the doctor carefully examined the styloid process to ensure it was not fractured.
3. Anatomy students often find the styloid features of the bones fascinating due to their unique shapes and functions.
4. The inflammation of the styloid process can lead to significant discomfort and is often referred to as Eagle syndrome.
5. In some individuals, the styloid bone may be elongated, which can contribute to throat pain and other symptoms.

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
