

SUBADUNCATE

Meaning: Subaduncate refers to a shape that is slightly tapered or narrowed just before the end, often used to describe plant leaves or flower petals.

1. The plant's leaves were described as subaduncate, tapering off just before the tip.
2. The botanist noted that the flower petals were subaduncate, giving them a unique shape.
3. In his detailed report, he mentioned how the subaduncate structure of the leaf aided in water conservation.
