Meaning: A subalmoner is an official in a church or organization responsible for distributing aid, such as food, to those in need.

1. The subalmoner was responsible for distributing food to the less fortunate in the community.
2. During the church service, the subalmoner quietly attended to the needs of the congregation.
3. The role of subalmoner often required a deep understanding of both charity and diplomacy.
4. In historical texts, the subalmoner is often depicted as a figure of compassion and service.
5. After years of dedicated service, she was promoted from assistant to the position of subalmoner.
