

SUBCIRCULAR

Meaning: Subcircular (adjective): having a shape that is nearly circular but not perfectly so, often used to describe objects or features that are slightly irregular in form.

1. The lake had a subcircular shape, which made it an unusual feature in the landscape.
2. During the excavation, archaeologists discovered a subcircular stone structure that suggested ancient habitation.
3. The subcircular design of the garden allowed for a unique flow of paths and flower beds.
4. In geology class, we learned that subcircular formations can indicate volcanic activity in the area.
5. The artist chose a subcircular canvas to create a striking visual contrast with the surrounding rectangular frames.
