Meaning: Subdialect: a distinct variation of a dialect, characterized by unique expressions and vocabulary, often specific to a particular region or community.

1. The region's subdialect is rich in unique expressions and vocabulary.
2. Linguists often study subdialects to understand the evolution of a language.
3. Her knowledge of the local subdialect allowed her to connect with the community.
4. Subdialects can reveal much about the culture and history of a specific area.
