

SUBDURAL

Meaning: Subdural refers to the space or area beneath the dura mater, the outermost membrane covering the brain and spinal cord, often associated with conditions such as hematomas or empyemas.

1. The patient was diagnosed with a subdural hematoma following the car accident.
2. Subdural empyema can lead to serious complications if not treated promptly.
3. Doctors monitored the subdural space for signs of increased pressure after the fall.
4. A subdural bleed can occur without a direct impact, often seen in elderly patients.
5. Treatment for a subdural infection may involve antibiotics and, in some cases, surgery.
