

SUBELONGATE

Meaning: Subelongate: having a shape that is somewhat elongated, but not to the extent of being fully elongated.

1. The botanist noted that the leaves of the newly discovered species were subelongate, differing from the typical elongated shape found in its relatives.
2. In certain aquatic plants, the subelongate stems allow for greater flexibility in turbulent waters.
3. The artist chose a subelongate canvas to better capture the sweeping landscape in her painting.

5. The engineer designed a subelongate component for the machinery to improve its efficiency and functionality.
