

SUBENDOCARDIAL

Meaning: Subendocardial refers to the layer of tissue located just beneath the inner lining of the heart (endocardium), which plays a vital role in the heart's electrical conduction and can be affected by conditions like ischemia.

1. The subendocardial layer of the heart is crucial for maintaining its electrical conduction system.
2. Patients with subendocardial ischemia may experience chest pain during physical exertion.
3. Imaging studies revealed damage to the subendocardial region following the patient's myocardial infarction.
4. The subendocardial tissue is particularly vulnerable to ischemic damage due to its location.
5. Research indicates that subendocardial fibrosis can lead to arrhythmias in patients with heart disease.
