

# SUBERATE

*Meaning: SUBERATE: To impregnate or coat with suberin, a waxy substance that enhances resistance to pathogens and improves durability.*

1. The researchers aimed to suberate the plant cells to enhance their resistance to pathogens.
2. To improve the lifespan of the wood, they decided to suberate it with a protective coating.
3. Suberating the roots allowed the plant to thrive in harsher environmental conditions.
