

# SUBGLOBOSE

*Meaning: Subglobose: having a shape that is nearly spherical but slightly flattened.*

1. The fruit of the tree is subglobose, resembling small spheres that dangle from the branches.
2. In botany, certain seeds are described as subglobose due to their rounded but slightly flattened shape.
3. The subglobose shape of the mushroom cap made it easily identifiable during the foraging expedition.
4. Some species of cacti produce subglobose fruits that are bursting with sweet, juicy flesh.
5. The artist chose to depict the subglobose forms in her sculpture, emphasizing their organic beauty.
