

SUBINFER

Meaning: Subinfer: to derive or deduce additional meaning or conclusions from existing information or evidence, often indirectly or implicitly.

1. The scientist decided to subinfer the results of the experiment to draw broader conclusions.
2. In her analysis, she chose to subinfer the motivations behind the character's actions rather than state them explicitly.
3. It can be problematic to subinfer too much from limited data, as it may lead to incorrect assumptions.
4. The detective had to subinfer the suspect's intentions based on their behavior during the investigation.
5. To subinfer meaning from the poem, one must consider the historical context in which it was written.
