

SUBJECTLESS

Meaning: Subjectless refers to a grammatical construction in which a sentence lacks an explicit subject, often leading to ambiguity about who is performing the action.

1. The subjectless construction in the sentence left readers confused about who was performing the action.
2. In some languages, subjectless sentences are quite common and convey meaning without explicit subjects.
3. The poet cleverly employed subjectless phrases to evoke a sense of mystery and ambiguity.
4. Subjectless clauses can sometimes enhance the flow of a conversation by making it more fluid and natural.
