Meaning: SUBLET (verb): To rent out a property or a portion of it to another person for a specified period, typically while the original tenant is temporarily away.

1. I decided to sublet my apartment while I traveled abroad for the summer.
2. Finding someone reliable to sublet your room can be a challenging process.
3. She chose to sublet her studio to a friend instead of letting it sit empty.
4. Many universities have resources to help students who want to sublet their housing.
