

SUBLOBULAR

Meaning: SUBLOBULAR: Relating to or resembling a small lobe or subdivision of a larger structure, particularly in anatomical contexts such as the liver.

1. The sublobular arteries branch off from the main hepatic artery, supplying blood to the liver.
