

SUBPREHENSILE

Meaning: Subprehensile refers to a limb or appendage that is capable of grasping or holding objects, but to a lesser degree than fully prehensile structures.

1. The octopus possesses a subprehensile arm that allows it to manipulate objects with surprising agility.
2. In certain species of lizards, the tail is subprehensile, enabling them to grasp branches while climbing.
