

SUBPYRIFORM

Meaning: Subpyriform: having a shape that is somewhat pear-like or resembling a pear, often characterized by a broader base and a tapering top.

1. The subpyriform shape of the fruit made it easy to identify among various other varieties.
2. In her research, she noted that the subpyriform design of the statue reflected the artist's unique style.
3. The geologist explained that the subpyriform structure of the rock was indicative of its formation process.
4. Many botanists classify the plant's leaves as subpyriform due to their distinctive tapering shape.
5. During the anatomy class, the professor highlighted the subpyriform characteristics of certain organs in mammals.
