Meaning: Subreptitious: characterized by stealthy or secretive behavior, often to avoid detection or scrutiny.

1. The subreptitious actions of the spy went unnoticed by everyone in the room.

3. His subreptitious glances at the confidential documents raised suspicions among the team.
4. The subreptitious manner in which the changes were implemented caused unrest among the employees.
5. They planned a subreptitious meeting to discuss the sensitive issue without drawing attention.
