

# SUBROGATE

*Meaning: SUBROGATE: To assume the legal rights of another party, typically in order to recover costs or damages from a third party responsible for a loss.*

1. The insurance company decided to subrogate its rights against the party responsible for the accident.
2. In cases of loss, the insurer may subrogate to recover costs from third parties.
3. After the claim was paid, the bank had the right to subrogate against the debtor.
4. The legal principle allows one party to subrogate another's rights to seek compensation.
5. As a result of the settlement, the plaintiff's insurer could subrogate against the defendant.
