

SUBSIDIARILY

Meaning: Subsidiarily means in a secondary or subordinate manner, often referring to an additional role or responsibility that is not the primary focus.

1. The company was responsible for managing the project and, subsidiarily, overseeing the budget.
2. The nonprofit organization provided direct services and, subsidiarily, supported educational initiatives in the community.
3. In the legal context, the main party is liable, while the affiliate is subsidiarily responsible for the obligations.
4. The research focused on climate change impacts and, subsidiarily, their effects on local economies.
5. The committee made recommendations for policy changes that would, subsidiarily, benefit the environment as well.
