Meaning: Subsidize: to provide financial support to reduce the cost of a service or expense, making it more affordable for individuals or groups.

1. The government decided to subsidize public transportation to make it more accessible for low-income families.
2. Many universities offer scholarships that subsidize tuition costs for deserving students.
3. In an effort to promote renewable energy, the state plans to subsidize solar panel installations for homeowners.
4. The organization aims to subsidize the cost of healthcare for underprivileged communities.
5. To encourage local businesses, the city will subsidize the rent for new startups in the downtown area.
