

SUBTRACT

Meaning: To subtract means to take one quantity away from another, resulting in a difference.

1. To find the total cost, you need to subtract the discount from the original price.
2. When you subtract two negative numbers, the result is actually a positive number.
3. In mathematics, you often need to subtract to solve for the unknown variable in an equation.
4. The teacher instructed the students to subtract the smaller fraction from the larger one.
5. If you subtract the expenses from your income, you'll see your profit or loss for the month.
