

SUFFUMIGATE

Meaning: Suffumigate: to purify or disinfect an area or object by exposing it to smoke or vapor, often from burning herbs or other substances.

1. The ancient practice of suffumigating herbs was believed to purify the air and ward off illness.
2. To ensure the safety of the food supply, the farmers decided to suffumigate their storage facilities against pests.
3. During the ceremony, they would suffumigate the sacred space with fragrant incense to invoke blessings.
4. The biologist explained how suffumigating the laboratory helped to eliminate unwanted contaminants from the experiments.
5. After the fire, the team had to suffumigate the entire building to remove the lingering smoke and toxins.
