

SUGGILLATION

Meaning: Suggillation is the appearance of bruising or discoloration of the skin caused by the rupture of blood vessels, often resulting from trauma.

1. The forensic expert noted that the bruising on the victim's neck was consistent with suggillation.
2. In the medical examination, the doctor explained how suggillation occurs when blood vessels break under the skin.
3. The detective was keen to determine whether the suggillation found on the body indicated foul play.
4. During the trial, the pathologist testified about the significance of suggillation in establishing the time of death.
5. Suggillation can often be a key indicator in cases of strangulation or other forms of trauma.
