

SUMPTUARY

Meaning: Sumptuary refers to laws or regulations intended to control personal expenditures and maintain social order by restricting extravagant behavior, particularly in clothing and consumption.

1. The sumptuary laws of the medieval period were designed to regulate extravagance among the nobility.
