*Meaning: Supercilium: the eyebrow or the arch of the eyebrow, often used to convey expression or emotion.*

1. The artist's depiction of the goddess emphasized her grace, particularly the delicate arch of her supercilium.
2. As she raised an eyebrow in disbelief, her supercilium seemed to convey a thousand unspoken words.
3. In classical sculpture, the careful treatment of the supercilium often signified the subject's nobility and poise.
4. He raised his supercilium in skepticism, questioning the validity of her extravagant claims.
5. The actor's ability to manipulate his supercilium added depth to his portrayal of the conflicted character.
