*Meaning: Supererogation is the performance of actions that exceed moral obligations or duties.*

1. Supererogation often refers to actions that go beyond the call of duty or obligation.
2. In ethics, the concept of supererogation challenges the notion of moral requirements.
3. Volunteering at the shelter is a clear example of supererogation in social responsibility.
4. Some philosophers debate whether supererogation should be considered a moral obligation in certain contexts.
5. Acts of kindness can be seen as supererogation when they exceed what is expected from an individual.
