

SUPEREROGATORY

Meaning: Supererogatory refers to actions that are performed beyond what is required or expected, often considered morally commendable but not obligatory.

1. Her decision to volunteer at the shelter every weekend was seen as supererogatory by her friends, who admired her commitment.
2. In philosophical discussions, actions that are supererogatory are those that go beyond what is morally required.
