Meaning: Superflux: an excessive or unnecessary amount of something, often leading to confusion or overwhelm.

1. The superflux of information available online can be overwhelming for many users.
2. In the context of the debate, his superflux of arguments seemed to confuse rather than clarify the issue.
3. The city experienced a superflux of tourists during the summer, leading to crowded streets and attractions.
4. Her superflux of ideas during the brainstorming session contributed to a highly innovative project proposal.
5. The ecosystem is struggling to adapt to the superflux of nutrients entering the waterway from agricultural runoff.
