

SUPERIMPOSE

Meaning: To superimpose means to place one image or element over another, often allowing both to be seen simultaneously.

1. The artist decided to superimpose a vibrant landscape over the monochromatic cityscape.
2. In her presentation, she chose to superimpose graphs to clearly illustrate the data trends.
3. The designer will superimpose the logo onto the product image for branding purposes.
4. To enhance the film's visual effects, they planned to superimpose digital elements onto the live-action footage.
5. The teacher used software to superimpose historical maps on current ones to show changes over time.
