

SUPERSCRIBE

Meaning: To superscribe means to write or inscribe (a name or signature) above or on the surface of a document or artwork.

1. To superscribe your name on the document, please use the designated space at the top.
2. The artist chose to superscribe her signature across the bottom of the canvas in bold letters.
3. In the world of publishing, it is customary to superscribe the author's name on the title page.
4. He decided to superscribe his thoughts in the margins of the book as he read it.
5. The label required us to superscribe the expiration date clearly for consumer safety.
