Meaning: Superscription refers to an inscription or heading placed at the top of a document that indicates its nature or purpose, often including details such as the sender or parties involved.

1. The superscription on the letter indicated it was a personal message from the president.
2. In legal documents, a superscription often specifies the parties involved in the agreement.
3. The artist's signature served as a superscription, adding value to the original painting.
4. The ancient manuscript featured a superscription that provided context for the text that followed.
5. Her contract included a superscription detailing the terms before the main body of the agreement.
