Meaning: Suppletory: serving to supply or provide additional information or support, often to clarify or enhance existing content.

1. The lawyer submitted a suppletory document to clarify the initial contract.
2. In the realm of education, supplementary materials serve as a suppletory resource for students.
3. The committee decided to include a suppletory measure to enhance the effectiveness of the main proposal.
4. Her findings were considered suppletory, providing additional support to the existing research.
