Meaning: Supposition: an uncertain belief or assumption made without firm evidence.

1. The scientist's theory was based on the supposition that all matter behaves in a consistent manner.
2. Her supposition about the project's timeline turned out to be more optimistic than realistic.
3. Many debates revolve around the supposition that human behavior can be predicted with enough data.
4. The teacher encouraged her students to challenge the supposition before accepting it as fact.
5. His initial supposition was that the team would win, but the outcome surprised everyone.
