

SUPPUTATE

Meaning: SUPPUTATE: to produce or discharge pus, typically as a result of infection or inflammation.

1. The doctor explained that the wound had begun to suppurate, requiring immediate attention.
2. After several days, the infection caused the abscess to suppurate, releasing a foul-smelling fluid.
3. If the injury continues to suppurate, we may need to consider surgical intervention.
4. Suppuration can indicate a serious infection that must be treated promptly to prevent complications.
