Meaning: Surmisa: a conjecture or inference based on limited evidence or reasoning.

2. Her surmisa about the weather proved accurate as the storm rolled in unexpectedly.
3. Without any concrete evidence, his surmisa about her feelings remained just a guess.
4. The surmisa that the project would be completed ahead of schedule excited the entire team.
5. Despite the lack of information, their surmisa about the company's future was surprisingly optimistic.
